



# Take flight with Toothless!


Learn how to train your very own dragon - a paper airplane dragon, that is. You'll need two sheets of paper and just a bit of patience. Let's start folding!














Start with an 8.5" x 11" sheet of paper.

Fold your paper in half lengthwise.


Now, fold each of the lower corners inward at a 45° angle towards the center fold.


Take the lower point and fold it upwards.






Fold the lower left and right corners inwards, like step 3.

Now, fold the outside edges in, lining them up with the center fold.

You should start to see your paper airplane take shape!



Unfold the wings from step 7.












Now, fold the outside edge to line up with the crease created in the last step.





Airplane check! Your paper plane should look like this.

Fold the point upwards as pictured, making sure it extends the top by 2".





Fold the top point downwards, <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" from the lower fold.












Now, fold your plane in half, making sure to line up each point.





Fold the wings down to create a ½" body for your paper plane.

Let's check our progress! Your paper plane should look like this.






Start trimming the back edge with rounded cuts to resemble dragon wings.

















Now, your plane should look like this!

**18**Grab a new sheet of 8.5" x 11" paper.

**19**Fold it in half lengthwise.


Sketch out the above shape along the fold of your paper, and cut it out.



Your folded tail should look similar to this, but you can be creative!

Insert the tail into the center fold, making sure to slide it in under the main wing.
