What you'll need




Glue stick



or wrapping paper



Scissors







Instructions

- 1. To make your very own DreamWorks matching game, print all the sheets of this activity out on plain white paper.
- 2. Time to let your creativity shine by coloring in all the characters!
- 3. Spread a thin layer of glue on the back of your character sheet, then place it on construction paper, pressing down to make sure it sticks. Repeat this step for all of your character sheets, then let them dry. Remember, use the same color construction paper for all sheets.
- 4. Once dried, cut along the dotted lines, and trim any excess construction paper off with the help of a grown-up.
- 5. Now you're ready to play!

How to Play

- 1. Start by laying all the cards on the table, character side down.
- 2. Flip two cards over and try to make a match. If you don't find a match, flip the cards back down, and try again.
- 3. Remember to keep a mental note of the face-down characters you see so you can make more pairs.
- 4. For a solo game, time yourself and try to beat your fastest round. When playing with a friend, take turns flipping 2 cards each. Once you get a match, keep that pair until all the characters have been found. The player with the most pairs wins!
